

The information below was extracted from various emails, as received from Judy Morganti in May and June 2021. Thank you Judy for your research and insights.

Regarding the Ragan families

I talked with Jean Buchbender last Thursday morning. She has no photos of Catherine, Eva or Juve Ragan, her aunts. She also does not have death notices.

I went to the Aurora Historians office of Thursday afternoon. I found that James B. Ragan and Jeremiah Collins Ragan were brothers. Their parents, John and Ellen Collins Ragan (she died in 1906) are buried in the Springbrook Catholic Cemetery. I also have a death notice from 1906 for her.

There are no death notices for James, Jeremiah, their spouses or children. However, Juve died in Phoenix, Arizona as per Jean Buchbender.

1.) According to the 1900 US census for Aurora, NY, Louis was a shoemaker, born May 1874 in Pennsylvania; Johanna wife, born March 1872 in Pennsylvania; Charles, son, was 2/12 months old and for in April 1900 in NY State.

2.) According to "Pennsylvania, 1s Marriages, 1852-1968" on [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com), Johanna L. Kelly age 28, and Louis Baetzhold, were married on May 3, 1899 in Susquehanna, PA.

3.) After Johanna's death, Louis married Marcella in 1904. (Sources:

"New York State, Marriage Index, 1881-1968", [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com) - Louis Baetzhold married Marcella Coyle on April 12, 1904 in Scio, New York; AND 1910 US Census, New York Census for Aurora - Louis and Marcella married 6 years. Living with them on Oakwood Avenue is Charlie, age 9, son, and Helen, 3, daughter. Louis is a cobbler.

4.) 1930 US census for NYS, Louis and Marcella lived at 558 Oakwood Ave.. Louis i a book binder. Living with them is Agnes, A Baetzhold, 20, daughter; Albert Wedgewood, 28, Son-in-law; Helen Wedgewood, 24, daughter; Albert J. Wedgewood 1, grandson. **FYI - Agnes Baetzhold and my mom, Margaret Little Keller, were best friends. Agnes was my mom's bride's maid.**

5.) 1940 US census for NYS, Louis and Marcella lived 558 Oakwood Ave. and Louis is a janitor at a parochial school.

5.) Louis C. Baetzhold died on Nov.17, 1945 at the age of 71 as per "New York, US, Death Index, 1852-1956", [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com)

Regarding Frederick & Josephine Youngers:

1.) Frederick Youngers and Josephine R. Juenker were married on June 7, 1905 in East Aurora, NY as per "New York State, Marriage Index, 1881-1967", Ancestry .com.

2.) As per the "U.S. WWI Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918", [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com), Frederick was born on April 12, 1884 and was a book binder for Elbert Hubbard II in East Aurora, NY.

3.)As per the "U, S. Draft Registration Cards, 1942", [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com), Fred Henry Youngers was a book binder for Acme Bindery on N. Division in Buffalo. His address was 333 So. Grove in East Aurora.

4.) As per the US 1930 census for New York, East Aurora, Frederick and Josephine lived at 333 So. Grove and had seven children. They owned their house and Fred was a book binder.

5.) According to the "New York, U.S. Death Index, 1852-1956" [Ancestry.com](https://www.ancestry.com), Frederick died on June 1, 1951 in East Aurora, NY.

As per Caroline Ess Youngers:

1. Caroline Youngers husband was Paul Youngers as per the U.S Census, New York State, East Aurora, NY. They had been married for 18 years and have four living children, Charles, Frederick, Josephine and Leo. They lived on Paine near Oakwood Avenue.

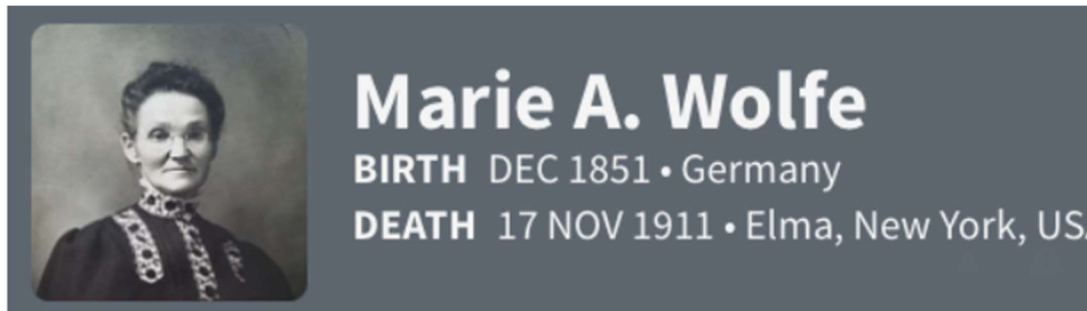


photo of Joseph Becker from Gloria Niedenhofer's tree:

Anthony (1835-1903) - Died April 25, 1907 as per p. 85 1 "New York, U.S., Death Index, 1853-1956", certificate #20048

Could not find any more information about him on any census

Catherine (1846-1917) - Died Feb. 17, 1917 as per p. 146 "New York, U.S., Death Index, 1853-1956", certificate #10696

"New York State Census" for 1855 - she is living with her parents, Owin and Judith Farley" in Marilla. Her parents were from Ireland. Catharine was 9 years old and born in Saratoga.

"1910 United States Census" for Marilla, New York", Catherine is living with her brother, William, in Marilla. She is a widow, age 59.
