DR. JERGE SUCSUMBS AFTER BRIEF ILLNESS

**East Aurora Physician's Rites
Will Be Conducted at 9:30
A. M. Wednesday.**

The funeral of Dr. I. Lewis Jerge, 37, will be held in the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Herman Jerge, 510 Main street, at 9:30 A. M. Wednesday, and in the Immaculate Conception church at 10 A. M., the Rev. Cornelius J. Cash officiating. Burial will be in Immaculate Conception cemetery, Bowen road. Members of the staff of Mt. Mercy hospital will act as honorary bearers.

Dr. Jerge, well-known East Aurora physician, died Saturday afternoon at Mt. Mercy hospital following an illness of five days.

Born in the Town of Elma on Aug. 19, 1893, he was graduated from the Hutchinson high school, Buffalo, in 1918 and from the University of Buffalo in 1924.

He was for one year a member of the staff of the City and the Children's hospitals, also two years on the staff of the State hospital. He began his practice in East Aurora in 1927. He had for two years been a member of the staff at Mt. Mercy hospital.

Dr. Jerge was a member of the Erie County Medical association and the Omega Upsilon Phi fraternity. He had for 27 years been a resident of East Aurora.

Besides his parents, he is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Karl Stephan, San Antonio, Tex., and Bertha D., at home. Also six brothers, Charles J., Herman Jr., Eugene P., Vincent A., East Aurora; Sutton X., Brooklyn, and Alvin J., Watertown.
