The Ninth Lesson: The followers of Jesus are commissioned to make disciples of all

This passage from the end of the Gospel according to Matthew is about the risen Jesus commissioning the eleven Apostles to make disciples of all nations.

It has an important message for all of us, especially at Christmas: Jesus, whose birth we celebrate at Christmas, remains with us, always.

will *help* us in accomplishing His work.
